

Sports Premium Statement- 2016/2017

Impact of Sports Premium 2015/2016

Observations have shown improvement in the quality of lessons delivered by teaching staff. After observing the sports leader (MSP) teachers and teaching assistants were observed teaching parts and whole lessons from the MSP leader's planning and then their own planning. The MSP leader will contact staff week via email to discuss planning and themes.

Competitions: Results from competitions demonstrate that pupils with a particular talent have been able to achieve at a high level.

Hands up surveys show increased participation in out of school sports, including football (boys and girls clubs), swimming, horse-riding, cricket and cross-country running.

The current Y6 pupils have been trained as "Playground leaders" and continue to run lunch-time activities for younger pupils.

Use of Sports Premium Funding 2016-2017

The school has received £8500 Sports Premium Funding for the year 2016-2017
