<p>No planned topic work but you could try one of these extra activities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Draw/write a Supertato or Evil Pea comic (template provided) You could retell the story of Supertato or focus on your favourite part. - Build a Superhero Den! - Potato printing -Make/eat some vegetable soup 	<p>ZOOM – 2:30pm</p> <p>You will need: Picture of trapped peas Rescue Plan sheet</p> <p>Join the Zoom session where the children will see the Evil Pea and his army trapped in green jelly.</p> <p>We will read the signs around the bowl which say HELP US! and BEWARE! POISONOUS!!</p> <p>I will ask the children what we should do. Should we help the Evil Pea? We will talk about how if we don't help him we would be unkind and unfriendly. If we help him we are showing him how to be a good friend and that it is good to be kind to others.</p> <p>We will have time to think about and talk about different rescue ideas.</p> <p>TASK: The children will be asked to complete the Rescue Plan sheet by drawing the different steps to their rescue plan.</p>	<p>Self Led (with video)</p> <p>You will need: Video on Tapestry Wanted Poster Template Evil Pea word bank</p> <p>Watch the video that has been uploaded to Tapestry.</p> <p>On the video, I will show the children what the Evil Pea has done at school!!</p> <p>I will ask the children to make a Wanted! poster for the Evil Pea so that we can catch him and stop him doing these naughty tricks!</p> <p>I will explain that they need to tell people what the Evil Pea is like using the word bank we created last week.</p> <p>I will show the children some examples of sentences they could write on their poster.</p> <p>TASK: Create your own WANTED! poster for the Evil Pea. Draw a picture and write (with help if needed) 2 sentences about the Evil Pea.</p>	<p>Self Led – am ZOOM – 2:00pm</p> <p>You will need: Mask template Bits and bobs to decorate mask Glue/scissors</p> <p>Read your child a letter from Supertato explaining that due to all their hard work over Lockdown and especially over the last two weeks helping to catch the Evil Pea, they have been granted Superhero Status!!</p> <p>However, everybody knows that all good superheroes have a mask!!
